Topic: One

The fundamental reality is that there is one perfect being: Infinite divine Mind unfolding its perfect ideas to bless. Infinite Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, Love.

The allness and oneness of God is the basis of Christian Science healing.

Christian Science nurses and practitioners bring this consciousness of "One" to healing, and it informs every aspect of their work. They are witnessing the patient's perfect oneness with God.

The Christian Science Pastor (the Bible and *Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures* by Mary Baker Eddy) provides the full revelation of the allness and oneness of God.

(Genesis 1:1, 31) "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good..."

(Psalm 103:2, 3) "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases"

(John 10:30) "I and my Father are one."

(Titus 2:11) "For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men"

(SH 267:5-6) "God is one. The allness of Deity is His oneness."

(SH 12:13) "... Jesus, whose humble prayers were deep and conscientious protests of Truth, — of man's likeness to God and of man's unity with Truth and Love."

(SH 102:9 only) "There is but one real attraction, that of Spirit."
